

UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT SCHEDULE OF FEES

The following fees are to be collected by the District Court pursuant to Title 28. They do not apply to the District of Columbia.

28 USC 1914(a). The Clerk of each district court shall require the parties instituting any civil action, suit, or proceeding in such court, whether by original process, removal or otherwise, to pay a filing fee of \$350.00, except that on application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus the filing fee shall be \$5.00.

The Judicial Conference of the United States, acting under the authority of Section 1914(b) of Title 28 of the United States Code, prescribed the following schedule of fees for United States District Courts, except that no fees are to be charged for services performed on behalf of the United States. No other fees for miscellaneous services than those prescribed by the Judicial Conference of the United States shall be charged or collected by any clerk of the court.
