16 Scholer LLP and Terry Tottenham of Fulbright & Jaworski LLP as Co-Lead Counsel for the
17 Defendants and D. Joseph Hurson of Lane Powell PC and Douglas A. Hofmann of Williams
18 Kastner & Gibbs, PLLC as Co-Liaison Counsel for the Defendants.

19 During the course of the MDL 1407 proceedings, various responsibilities were placed
20 on and carried out by Lead and Liaison Counsel for the Defendants. Liaison Counsel for the
21 Defendants, as a consequence of its various responsibilities, has in its possession copies of
22 extensive discovery materials, including completed Plaintiff's Fact Sheets, which should
23 otherwise be in possession of the relevant defendants.
