


Dear Mr. Rifkin:



ORDER LIFTING STAY OF CONDITIONAL TRANSFER ORDER

A conditional transfer order was filed in this action (*Anderson*) on January 23, 2002. Prior to expiration of that order's fifteen-day stay of transmittal, defendant Dolgencorp, Inc. (Dolgencorp) filed a notice of opposition to the proposed transfer of *Anderson* and the subsequent motion and brief to vacate the conditional transfer order. Dolgencorp has now advised the Panel that it withdraws its initial opposition to the conditional transfer order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the stay of the Panel's conditional transfer order designated as "CTO-9" filed on January 23, 2002, is LIFTED insofar as it relates to this action, and thus the action is transferred to the Western District of Washington for inclusion in the coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings under 28 U.S.C. §1407 being conducted by the Honorable Barbara Jacobs Rothstein.


