IN CHAMBERS PROCEEDING:

The parties requested that the court resolve a dispute over page limitations on the briefing for defendants' Daubert challenges. Having considered the parties' positions, the court ordered that both defendants and plaintiffs be limited to a total of seventy-five (75) pages in briefing this issue, with defendants' reply brief totaling no more than thirty (30) pages. The court did not resolve the question of whether plaintiffs should be afforded the opportunity to file a sur-reply, and suggested that the parties request further assistance from the court in the event this issue could not be resolved.
