1 **STIPULATION**

2 Now come the Parties, by counsel, in the Economic Injury Class Action Cases and
3 stipulate as follows:

4 A. The Parties have met and conferred regarding the briefing schedule for Plaintiffs'
5 Motion and Memorandum for Injunctive Relief in the Form of Emergency Notice and
6 Defendants' Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings Regarding Plaintiffs' Claims for Injunctive
7 Relief in Economic Class Action Cases. Both motions were filed on March 1, 2002.

8 B. Plaintiffs' Motion for Injunctive Relief in the Form of Emergency Notice and
9 Defendants' Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings Regarding Plaintiffs' Claims for Injunctive
10 Relief contain overlapping issues. Due to the overlapping issues, the Parties have agreed to
11 combine the briefing schedule and construct an efficient briefing schedule for the responsive and
12 reply briefs for these motions.

13 C. The Parties have agreed to combine the briefing in the following manner:

14 1. On April 12, 2002, Defendants will file a brief in Opposition to Plaintiffs'
15 Motion for Injunctive Relief in the Form of Emergency Notice;

16 2. On April 29, 2002, Plaintiffs will file a reply brief in Support of Plaintiffs
17 Motion for Injunctive Relief in the Form of Emergency Notice and in Opposition to Defendants'
18 Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings Regarding Plaintiffs' Claims for Injunctive Relief; and

19 3. On May 13, 2002, Defendants will file a reply brief in Support of
20 Defendants' Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings Regarding Plaintiffs' Claims for Injunctive
21 Relief.


22 D. The schedule outlined above has no bearing on the briefing schedule for

25 Plaintiffs' Reply on May 13, 2002.


