IN CHAMBERS PROCEEDING:

All pending motions in MDL 1407 cases where a stay is in effect are hereby STRICKEN. Parties may not re-file a stricken motion unless or until the stay is lifted in a particular case.

Any future motions filed in stayed cases which are not explicitly permitted under the relevant stay order or any other order of the court will be stricken.

The court is aware of the existence of certain motions that properly may be ruled on by the court, despite a stay being in effect. This Minute Order is not intended to disallow a party from re-filing such a motion. Such motions shall be re-filed within ten (10) days of entry of this Minute Order, and shall make clear why ruling is permissible under the relevant stay order. Opposition to re-filed motions shall be filed no later than twenty-one (21) days after service of the re-filed motions, and replies shall be filed no later than seven (7) days after service of opposition briefing.
