IN CHAMBERS PROCEEDING:

It has come to the court's attention that confusion has arisen regarding whether the parties' obligations under CMOs 18 and 18B have been stayed pending a resolution of the 30-day discovery period relating to the Korean Study. Although the court acknowledged that a stay of such obligations pending a ruling on plaintiffs' motion to compel was in the interest of all parties, the court ruled on that motion on September 17, 2004 and the temporary suspension of the CMOs 18 and 18B obligations, accordingly, was lifted at that time.

Recognizing that the confusion has arisen in good faith and as a result of a somewhat ambiguous discussion during the telephonic hearing on the motion to compel, the court hereby and explicitly reinstates any and all deadlines and obligations under CMOs 18 and 18B as of the date of this order.
