

Pursuant to 28 United States Code, Section 636(f), and with the concurrence of the Chief Judge, United States District Court, Eastern District of Washington, the court finds that there is an emergency requiring the temporary assignment of United States Magistrate Judge Cynthia Imbrogno, Eastern District of Washington, to perform certain duties in this district.

The nature of the existing emergency is the need for all full-time Magistrate Judges in this district to attend a meeting of all judges of this court on the afternoon of February 25, 1998, a date and time for which there is also scheduled a misdemeanor and petty offense arraignment calendar which cannot be changed without substantial expense and inconvenience to numerous persons assigned that arraignment date by the Central Violations Bureau. Magistrate Judge Imbrogno's duties will consist of presiding over that calendar on the day in question only, arraigning all persons appearing before the court, assigning trial dates, accepting any pleas of guilty which may be entered, imposing any sentences which may be appropriate, and exercising any additional judicial powers which may be usual and necessary for the performance of her duties.
