

### **Motion Noting Date Requirements: Local Rules CR 7(b) and (d)**

The motion's noting date shall be placed in the caption. After receiving all pleadings relevant to the motion, the Court will determine whether additional briefing or oral argument are necessary, or whether the matter may be decided on the pleadings.

#### **Note the following motions for consideration for the day they are filed:**

- Stipulated or agreed
- Request for over-length pleading
- Reconsideration
- Default and Default Judgment
- Joint submissions
- Ex Parte

**All other motions shall be noted on a Friday.**

**Motions are to be noted 2 Fridays after filing. Responses are due Wednesday before the noting date. (This noting date does not apply where a party is under confinement.)**

- Relief from deadline
- Protective order
- Seal

**Motions are to be noted 3 Fridays after filing. Responses are due the Monday before the noting date.**

- Other non-dispositive motions
- Amended pleadings
- Default (where opposing party has appeared)
- Discovery
- Quash
- Tax and retax costs
- Withdraw as Attorney

**Motions are to be noted 4 Fridays after filing. Responses are due the Monday before the noting date.**

- Dispositive motions (dismiss and summary judgment)
- Preliminary Injunctions

**Motions in Limine**

Note no earlier than 3 Fridays from filing, but in no event later than the Friday before Pretrial Conference
