8 It is by the Court hereby ORDERED that:

9
10 1. The word "Thursday" in next to the last line
11 in Rule 8(b), "Local Rules W. D. Wash.", is stricken and
12 the word "Wednesday" is substituted therefor.

13 In Rule 8(c), "Local Rules W. D. Wash.", in the
14 first sentence, the word "Thursday" is stricken and the
15 word "Wednesday" is substituted therefor; and the second
16 sentence reading "Any such matters filed on Friday or
17 Saturday will be heard upon the second Monday following."
18 is stricken and abolished.

19
20 2. Rule 16, "Local Rules W. D. Wash.", is hereby
21 amended by adding thereto the following:

22 "(c) In civil cases, black background photostatic
23 copies of writings, maps, drawings and diagrams shall not
24 be admissible in evidence nor filed nor attached to nor
25 incorporated in any pleading, unless otherwise directed by
26 the Court upon good cause shown."

29 3. Rule 19, "Local Rules W. D. Wash.", is hereby
30 abolished.

1 4. Rule 45, "Local Rules W. D. Wash.", is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Rule 45. Direction as to Mileage of Witnesses.

4 All witnesses attending Court, whether residing
5 within or without the city where the Court is held, shall
6 be allowed mileage for the distance actually traveled by
7 the nearest available route each way between the places of
8 residence and the court house. Witnesses who thus travel
9 daily while attending Court shall be paid mileage for one
10 round trip daily at 7¢ per mile, not exceeding the total
11 sum of \$5.00 for such round trip."

12
13 5. A new rule is hereby added to "Local Rules
14 W. D. Wash.", as follows:

15 "Rule 51A. Bond on Removal -- Amount of.

16 In civil case removals from the State to the
17 Federal Court, the removing party shall serve and file a
18 removal bond in the sum of \$250, provided such bond may
19 from time to time for good cause shown be increased to
20 such additional amounts as the Court may direct."

21
22 6. A new rule is hereby added to "Local Rules
23 W. D. Wash.", as follows:

24 "Rule 51B. Bail Bond -- Condition against Leaving Juris-
25 diction.

26 In all criminal cases, whether pending before a U. S.
27 Commissioner or the Court, all bonds, cash bail agreements
28 and personal recognizances shall be conditioned that the
29 defendant, among other things, shall not leave the Court's
30 jurisdiction without first filing in Court the written con-
31 sent of the surety, when there is a surety, nor without the
32 Court's approval first obtained and entered in the Court's
records before such leaving of the District."

1 7. Rule 56(g)(2), "Local Rules W. D. Wash.", is
2 hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "(2) Where a witness has attended from a point
4 without the district, his mileage shall be taxed according
5 to the distance actually and necessarily traveled by him
6 within the limits of the district, subject to the limita-
7 tions stated in Rule 45, 'Local Rules W. D. Wash.'"

8
9 8. Rule 56(g)(3), "Local Rules W. D. Wash.", is
10 hereby amended to read as follows:

11 "(3) The mileage of witnesses attending from
12 points within the district shall be taxed according to the
13 distance actually and necessarily traveled, subject to the
14 limitations stated in Rule 45, 'Local Rules W. D. Wash.'"

15
16 9. Rule 65, "Local Rules W. D. Wash.", is hereby
17 amended by adding thereto the following:

18 "(g) All Habeas Corpus proceedings, whether or
19 not addressed to a named Judge, instituted by or for
20 persons detained in the Southern Division of this District,
21 shall be filed in the office of this Court's Clerk at
22 Tacoma; and if such proceedings are instituted by or for
23 a person detained in the Northern Division of this District
24 they shall be filed in the office of this Court's Clerk at
25 Seattle, except that if such proceedings are instituted by
26 or for a person detained in the counties of Whatcom, San
27 Juan or Skagit, they shall be filed in the office of this
28 Court's Clerk at Bellingham."

10. A new rule is hereby added to "Local Admiralty Rules, W. D. Wash." as follows:

"Rule 25A. Discovery.

All Federal Rules of Civil Procedure relating to discovery and discovery procedures shall be applicable to proceedings in admiralty, provided that the Court may upon showing of hardship or inconvenience deny, limit or condition such applicability."
