UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT WESTERN DISTRICT OF WASHINGTON AT SEATTLE IN THE MATTER OF GENERAL ORDER 01-12 JURY FEES Pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 1871(b)(2) and (3), when a petit juror is required to attend more than ten (10) days of actual petit jury service (including days of travel) or a grand juror is required to attend more than forty-five (45) days of actual grand jury service (including days of travel), the juror may be paid an additional fee not exceeding \$10.00 more than the attendance fee for each day in excess of the ten (10) days of actual petit jury service or forty-five (45) days of grand jury service, unless the presiding judge determines in his or her discretion that such enhanced fees are not appropriate and direct that they not be paid.

IT IS ORDERED that in the Western District of Washington grand jurors serving in excess of forty-five (45) days and petit jurors serving in excess of ten (10) days of actual jury service (including days of travel) shall receive an additional attendance fee of \$10 for each successive day (including travel days) until such petit or grand juror is excused, unless the presiding judge determines in his or her discretion that such enhanced fees are not appropriate and directs that they not be paid.
