GENERAL ORDER

In accordance with the implementation of ten percent increase to transcript fee rates approved by the Judicial Conference, the guidelines of the Judicial Conference of the United States, and the approval of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective March 14, 2003, the maximum per page rates that may be charged for transcripts by a Court Reporter in this District are amended and shall be:

Ordinary Transcript	\$3.30	\$.83	.55
Expedited Transcript	4.40	.83	.55
Daily Transcript	5.50	.10	.83
Hourly Transcript	6.60	1.10	.83
Realtime Transcript	2.75	1.10	

The term "Ordinary Transcript" is a transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.

The term "Expedited Transcript" is a transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.

4 The term "Daily Transcript" is a transcript to be delivered following adjournment and
5 prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning whether or not it
6 actually is a court day.

7 The term "Hourly Transcript" is a transcript of proceedings ordered under unusual
8 circumstances to be delivered within two (2) hours.

9 The term "Realtime Transcript" is a draft unedited transcript produced by a
10 certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during
11 proceedings or immediately following adjournment.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of the fee schedule shall be posted in the
13 office of the Clerk.
