10	In accordance with guidance approved by the Executive Committee of the Judicial
11	Conference of the United States, the Court adopts the following criteria to insure that written
12	opinions of the Court are available to the public at no cost via the PACER system.
13	
14	"Written Opinion" is defined as "any document issued by a judge or judges of the court,
15	sitting in that capacity, that sets forth a reasoned explanation for a court's decision." This
16	definition is clarified by the following points:
17	(1) That the responsibility for determining which documents meet this definition rests
18	with the authoring judge, which determination shall be made at the time the
19	document is filed;
20	(2) That the decision as to whether a document meets this definition is not the same as
20	the decision about whether an opinion is to be published;
22	(3) That the definition is expressly intended to cover any Report and Recommendation
23	issued by a Magistrate Judge, as well as the District Judge's Order Adopting the
24	Report and Recommendation or an Order Denying the Report and Recommendation.

(4) That the definition is not intended to include routine, non-substantive orders such as

scheduling orders and orders on motions for extension of time.
