ORDER

For good cause therefor appearing, IT IS ORDERED
that the local rules of this court are amended as follows:

(a) As required by Public Law 88-139, 88th Congress,
H. R. 2845, approved October 16, 1963, terms of court are
abolished and all references thereto in the local rules of
this court are stricken.

(b) The Court shall be in continuous session in
the Northern Division at Seattle and in the Southern Division
at Tacoma. The Court shall hold special sessions in the
Northern Division at Bellingham at such times as necessary
and upon such notice as the Court orders.

(c) Petit jury panels shall be impaneled in the
Northern Division at Seattle for terms of service beginning
on the first Tuesdays in May and November, and in the
Southern Division at Tacoma for terms of service beginning
on the first Tuesdays in February and August; at Bellingham
in the Northern Division for terms of service at such times
as the Court shall designate.

The effective date of this order shall be
April 1, 1964.
