GENERAL ORDER NO. 10-04

9
10 The Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure authorize this
11 court to establish practices and procedures for the filing, signing, and verification of pleadings and
12 papers by electronic means.

13 **IT IS ORDERED that:**

14 1. The docketing and case management system for the Western District of Washington shall be
15 the judiciary's Case Management and Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) Program. In conjunction with
16 CM/ECF, the official record of the court shall be the electronic file maintained on the court's servers.

17 2. At the direction of the court, the Clerk of Court has developed and posted on the court's
18 website the Electronic Filing Procedures to be followed by the parties.

19 3. The time frame for the enactment of the electronic filing procedures is set out in the court's
20 Electronic Filing Procedures.

21 4. The electronic filing of a pleading or other paper in accordance with the court's electronic
22 filing procedures shall constitute entry of that pleading or other paper on the docket kept by the Clerk
23 of Court pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 79 and Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure 49 and
24 55.

25 5. The court shall enter all orders, decrees, judgments and proceedings of the court in accordance
26 with the electronic filing procedures, which shall constitute entry of the order, decree, judgment or
27 proceeding on the docket kept by the Clerk of Court.

3 6. Participation in the CM/ECF system by registration and receipt of a login and password from
4 the Clerk of Court shall constitute consent to the electronic service of pleadings and other papers
5 pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 5 and the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure.

6 7. All conflicting orders concerning the provisions for electronic case filing heretofore
7 entered are vacated by this order. This order shall be effective immediately and remain in force until
8 rescinded.
