Med. 137, it is hereby agreed and ordered by the undersigned Judges of this Court that the division of this Court's business among the Judges and the assignment of such business to the calendars of the undersigned Judges respectively for bearing, trial and disposition be and are hereby made as follows:

Of the causes and proceedings hereafter filed at Seattle, Judge Bowen will dispose of marine admiralty causes, condemnation and forfeiture cases filed on the edmiralty side of the Court, proceedings for review of awards under the Longshoremen's and Harbor Workers' Act, proceedings respecting the wages and effects of deceased and deserting seamon, hearings upon U. S. Commissioner transcripts and/or concorning matters pending before such Commissioner, criminal case removals other than transfers under Criminal Rule 20, all matters relating to grand juries and their sessions at Seattle and Bellingham, and petitions for admission to the Bor.

Of the causes and proceedings hereafter filed at Souttle, Judge Lindberg will dispose of Bankruptcy Act proceedings including actions by or against bankruptcy trustees, national bank insolvency and receivership cases, naturalization and denaturalization proceedings, actions testing or

concerning citizenship or nationality, proceedings (civil 1 and criminal) involving illegal entry and deportation of 2 sliens, babeas corpus petitions whether or not addressed to 3 a named judge, proceedings concerning the logality of present 4 or prospective official and non-official detention of gersons 5 except proceedings under 28 USCA, Sec. 2255 which Section $\,\,^{\prime}$ 6 7 controls jurisdiction as to such Sec. 2255 proceedings, pro-8 ceedings under Criminal Rule 7 for waiver of indictments 9 and filing of informations, applications for transfer of 10 eriminal cases under Criminal Rule 20, Security and Exchange 11 Commission proceedings, and unassigned on parte matters. 12 All Seattre business of the Court other than that 13 above montioned, civil and criminal, hereafter filed at 14 Seattle shall be disposed of one-half by Judge Bowen and 15 one-half by Judge Lindberg. 16 Of the causes and proceedings filed at Bellingham, 17 Jadge Lindberg will dispose of Bankruptcy Act proceedings 18 and Judge Bowen will dispose of all other Bellingham business 19 of the Court including actions by or against bankruptey 20 trustees. 21Unless otherwise spacifically ordered the Clark 22 is hereby directed to make assignments to the calendars of 23 Judges Bowen and Lindberg in accordance with the foregoing 24simultaneously with the filling of matters in the Clerk's 25office. 26All causes and proceedings bereafter fited at 27 Tacoma, and all habeas corpus proceedings, whether or not 28 addressed to a named judge, instituted by or for persons 29 detained in the Southern Division of this Court, and all 30 matters relating to grand juries and their sessions in that 31

Division, and hereby assigned to Judge Leavy for hearing,

trial, decision and disposition. The Clerk is directed to assign such Tacoma and Southern Division matters to Judge Leavy's calendar. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, each of the Judges of this Court shall have and perform any and all of the authority and daty otherwise by law conferred upon him to hear, try and discoso of any and all of the causes, matters and business of this Court when he consents to do so. All conflicting agreements and orders and parts thereof heretofore made or entered are hereby vacated. This agreement and order are for the Court and for each and all of the Judges, hereby made and entered by each and all of the undersigned being all of the Judges of this Court, and shall continue in effect until further order.
