7 (p) Perform the functions specified in 18 U.S.C. §§ 4107, 4108  
8 and 4109, regarding proceedings for verification of consent by  
9 offenders to transfer to or from the United States, and appoint  
10 counsel in such cases; and

11 (q) Accept waivers of indictment and guilty pleas in felony  
12 cases with the consent of the defendant, the defendant's attorney,  
13 and the United States, and to order a presentence investigation  
14 report concerning any defendant who pleads guilty to felony charges  
15 (Rules 7(b), 11(a), and 32(c), Fed.R.Crim.P.). In such cases, the  
16 United States Magistrate Judge may conduct the proceedings required  
17 by Rule 11, Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, and, if the plea is  
18 accepted, order a presentence investigation report pursuant to  
19 Rule 32, Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure.

20 If the Magistrate Judge accepts the plea, the United States  
21 Magistrate Judge shall file a report and recommendation with the  
22 District Judge to whom the case has been assigned. A copy of such  
23 report and recommendation shall be served on all parties. Within  
24 ten (10) days after such service, any party may file and serve  
25 written objections thereto, and any party desiring to oppose such  
26 objections shall have five (5) days thereafter within which to file  
and serve a written response. The District Judge may accept,

1 reject, or modify, in whole or in part, the report and  
2 recommendation of the Magistrate Judge. Sentencing shall take place  
3 before the District Judge to whom the case has been assigned.

4 This rule in no way precludes any District Judge from reserving  
5 the function of conducting the proceedings required by Rule 11 in  
6 any/all case(s) assigned to the District Judge.
