GENERAL ORDER

No persons, including law enforcement officers, shall bring or bear any firearm or other weapon into the United States Courthouse without the specific authority of the Judge presiding over a particular matter or by Order of the Chief Judge.

The United States Marshal and Deputy United States Marshals, or those acting in an official capacity under the direction and control of the United States Marshal, are exempt from the above Order. Case agents, the United States Attorney, or Assistant United States Attorneys transporting weapons that are to be, or have been, admitted as evidence may bring these weapons into the Courthouse as long as such weapons are unloaded and locked in such a manner as to prevent loading and firing. Law enforcement officers delivering prisoners to the Marshal's cellblock are exempt until the prisoners are secured in the cellblock area.
