In accordance with the guidelines of the Judicial Conference of the United States, and with the approval of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective November 1, 1987, the maximum per page rates that may be charged for transcripts by a Court Reporter in this District are amended and shall be:

|                      | Original | First Copy | Additional Copy |
|----------------------|----------|------------|-----------------|
| Ordinary Transcript  | \$3.00   | \$ .75     | \$ .50          |
| Expedited Transcript | 4.00     | .75        | .50             |
| Daily Transcript     | 5.00     | 1.00       | .75             |
| Hourly Transcript    | 6.00     | 1.00       | .75             |

The term "Expedited Transcript" is a transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of the order.

The term "Daily Transcript" is a transcript to be delivered

1 following adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the  
2 Court on the following morning, whether it actually be a court  
3 day.

4 The term "Hourly Transcript" is a transcript of proceedings  
5 ordered under unusual circumstances to be delivered within two (2)  
6 hours.

7 Provided that said maximum allowable rates will not apply as  
8 to any transcripts paid for by the Government<sup>1</sup>. Such transcripts  
9 will be governed by the Court's order of July 1, 1985.

10 Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §753 (f), official court reporters  
11 shall not charge a fee for any copy of a transcript delivered to  
12 the Clerk for the records of the court.




