O R D E R

It is by the Court hereby ORDERED that:

1. Rule 2 of "Local Rules W. D. Wash.", (relating to eligibility for admission to this Court's Bar) shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Rule 2. Eligibility. Any person who has been a resident of and has actually lived in the State of Washington for six months immediately preceding the filing of his application and the granting of his admission and who is a member in good standing of the bar of (1) the highest court of this state or of (2) the highest court of any other state, or of any organized territory of the United States, is eligible for admission to the bar of this court.

2. The oath to be administered to applicants for admission provided in Rule 3, "Local Rules W. D. Wash." (relating to procedure for admission) shall be in the following form:

OATH OF ATTORNEYS

I solemnly swear that I will support and defend the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America against all enemies, foreign and domestic; that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same; that I will well and faithfully discharge my duties as a lawyer, counsellor and proctor of this Court; that I will maintain the respect due to the Courts of justice and judicial officers and that I will demean myself uprightly and according to ~~the~~ law and the recognized standards of ethics of the legal profession, SO HELP ME GOD.

This order shall be in full force and effect on and after this date.
