[See Rule 7(c)(3) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure.]



Each section of RCW 46 set out on the following pages 2-9 is classified for Federal purposes as either a petty offense or a misdemeanor.

Where the section is noted as being a "MISDEMEANOR-1," the maximum sentence is imprisonment of not more than one year and/or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00. (See RCW 46.64.050, RCW 9.92.020, and 18 U.S.C. § 1.)

Where the section is noted as being a "MISDEMEANOR-2," the maximum sentence is imprisonment of not more than 90 days and/or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00. (See RCW 46.64.050, RCW 9.92.030, and 18 U.S.C.

§ 1--RCW 9A.20.020 would not appear to be applicable to crimes defined in Title 46 as 9A applies only to crimes "defined in Title 9A.")

PETTY OFFENSE sections and MISDEMEANOR sections other than MISDEMEANOR-1 and MISDEMEANOR-2 sections set out the applicable penalties for the section.

[NOTE: DO NOT BE CONFUSED BY THE TERMINOLOGY USED IN THE REVISED CODE OF WASHINGTON (RCW). WHAT THE STATE LABELS A "MISDEMEANOR" MAY BE A FEDERAL PETTY OFFENSE OR A FEDERAL MISDEMEANOR. WHAT THE STATE LABELS A "GROSS MISDEMEANOR" IS A FEDERAL MISDEMEANOR.]

Cannot suspend or defer as to the one day minimum unless physical or mental problem and reason for suspension or deferral must be set out in writing.

Second conviction within five-year period, imprisonment for not less than seven days nor more than one year and a fine not more than \$1,000.00. Cannot suspend or defer as to the seven-day minimum unless physical or mental problem and reason for suspension or deferral must be set out in writing.

For third and subsequent .504 physical control convictions within a five-year period, same as a second conviction.

For a third and subsequent .502 DWI convictions within a five-year period, a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$1,000.00, and imprisonment for not less than 30 days and not more than one year, and neither minimum fine nor minimum imprisonment sentence may be suspended; and the Court is to revoke license.--See RCW 46.52.100.

If also driving while license suspended or revoked at time of second or subsequent conviction, minimum sentence is not less than 90 days and not less than a \$200.00 fine which cannot be suspended or deferred. See RCW 46.52.100 and 46.61.515.

In addition to any nonsuspendable and nondeferrable jail sentence required for a second or subsequent conviction, the sentence is to be imprisonment not exceeding 180 days, which is to be suspended, but not deferred, for not more than 2 years.

In addition to any fine and costs, there is a minimum 25% (of any fines and costs) penalty assessment, to be paid to highway safety fund. The penalty assessment may not be deferred, suspended, waived, or modified.
