### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF.

### THE "SCHEDULE"

For certain Federal misdemeanors and infraction charges listed in the "Schedule," defendants in the Western District of Washington have the option to pay a fixed sum to the Clerk of Court instead of appearing in court. If a defendant makes such a payment timely, that amount is forfeited; defendant need not appear in court; and the case is closed.

The Court has adopted this "Schedule" listing all misdemeanor offenses and infractions for which a defendant has that option and also listing all infractions and misdemeanors that require a mandatory appearance. An officer who issues a citation or violation notice should be certain how the offense charged is treated in the "Schedule":

- (a) If the "Schedule" provides a dollar amount of bail for the offense in question, that amount must be entered in the box at the lower right on the citation or Violation Notice.

  NOTE: Neither the officer, his superior, nor the United States

  Magistrate has discretion to vary from the provisions of the "Schedule" in a given case.
- (b) If the offense is listed as "Mandatory," the charge is not one which can be resolved by forfeiting a specified amount, and the defendant must appear in court when directed, i.e., when notified to appear by the Central Violations Bureau (CVB) in San Antonio, Texas.

(c) If the offense is not listed in the "Schedule," a citation or Violation Notice should not be issued. If the officer or agency believes prosecution is appropriate for unlisted violations, the matter should be referred to the Complaint Section of the United States Attorney's Office, 3600 Seafirst Fifth Avenue Plaza, 800 Fifth Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98104, telephone number (206) 553-7970.

Authority for the adoption of the "Schedule" is based upon Rule 58(d) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure. In the Western District of Washington, the full-time United States Magistrate Judges are authorized to establish and, from time to time, amend the "Schedule" by Local Rule MJR 9(j).

Suggested modifications or additions to the "Schedule" and questions about its use should be presented in writing to the Chief of the Complaints Section, United States Attorney's Office, 3600 Seafirst Fifth Avenue Plaza, 800 Fifth Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98104, telephone number (206) 553-7970.

Amendments consisting of new or substitute pages will be distributed by the United States Attorney's Office as they are made by the Court from time to time. Each office or agency is responsible for making its officers or agents aware of all relevant changes and for maintaining a current copy of the "Schedule."

Under Federal law, a Felony is an offense punishable by death or by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year. No felonies are listed in the "Schedule."

Under Federal law, a Felony is an offense punishable by death or by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year. No felonies are listed in the "Schedule."

Under recent changes in the federal laws there has been a restructuring of lesser offenses. Under Federal law, a Misdemeanor is any offense punishable by imprisonment not exceeding one year. Within the Misdemeanor definition, there are now three classes of Misdemeanors:

Class A Misdemeanors:

An offense that has a maximum imprisonment of one (1) year, but no more than six (6) months.

Class B Misdemeanors:

An offense that has a maximum

Class B Misdemeanors: An offense that has a maximum imprisonment of six (6) months, but more than thirty (30) days.

Class C Misdemeanors: An offense that has a maximum imprisonment of thirty (30) days, but more than five (5) days.

Under Federal law, a Petty Offense is an offense for which the maximum period of imprisonment does not exceed six (6) months. Class B misdemeanors, Class C misdemeanors and Infractions would come under the "Petty Offense" category.

Under Federal law, an Infraction is an offense that has a maximum of five (5) days or less, or no imprisonment authorized.

The specific offense that is charged will have a maximum term of imprisonment which will then tell you whether it is a Misdemeanor, Petty Offense, or an Infraction.

The maximum fines for Federal offenses have also been changed and they are as follows:

Class A Misdemeanors: Not more than \$100,000.00

Class B Misdemeanors: Not more than \$ 5,000.00

Class C Misdemeanors: Not more than \$ 5,000.00

Infraction: Not more than \$ 5,000.00

These maximum fine amounts only apply to Federal offenses, like those found in Title 18, Title 16, and the CFR's. These maximum fine amounts do not apply to state offenses.

State offenses which are assimilated under the Assimilated Crimes Act are not subject to the new maximum Federal fines. The maximum imprisonment and fine that is set by the State Statute applies when an offense is assimilated into the Federal system.

An offense is an Infraction when the maximum sentence of imprisonment is not more than 5 days or less, or if no imprisonment is authorized and a fine of not more than \$5,000 or both.

(1) A person violating RCW 77.16.040, 77.16.050, 77.16.060, 77.16.080, 77.16.210, 77.16.310, or 77.32.211; or committing a violation of RCW 77.16.020 or 77.16.120, involving big game or an endangered species is guilty of a gross misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars and not more than One Thousand Dollars or by imprisonment in the county iail for not less than thirty days and not more than one year or by both the fine and imprisonment. Each subsequent violation within a five year period of RCW 77.16.040, 77.16.050, or 77.16.060, or of RCW 77.16.020 or 77.16.120 involving big game or an endangered species as defined by the Washington State Game Commission under the authority of RCW 77.04.090, shall be prosecuted and punished as a Class C felony as defined in RCW 9A.20.020.

#### CLASS B MISDEMEANORS

(2) A person violating or failing to comply with this title or a rule of the Commission for which no penalty is otherwise provided is quilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished for each offense by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars or by imprisonment for not more than ninety days in the county jail or by both the fine and imprisonment.
