10 It is by the Court hereby ORDERED that Rule 2,
11 "Local Rules W. D. Wash.", is hereby amended to read as
12 follows:

13 "Rule 2. Eligibility.

14 Any person who has been a resident of and has actually
15 lived in the State of Washington for six months immediately
16 preceding the filing of his application and the granting of
17 his admission and who is a member in good standing of the bar
18 of (1) the highest court of this State or of (2) the highest
19 court of any other state, or of any organized territory of
20 the United States, is eligible for admission to the bar of
21 this Court;

22 Provided, that the foregoing "actually lived" requirement
23 shall not apply to the absence of a resident from this State
24 for the purpose only of attending school or service in the
25 U.S. Armed Forces or engaging in seasonal or brief employment
26 or occasional non-work activity.
