GENERAL ORDER

The court's General Order dated September 25, 1995, and entered on November 13, 1995, regarding the continuation of all operations and services needed to maintain and support the exercise and resolution of cases during the absence of appropriations inadvertently omitted recognizing that the operations of the Federal Public Defender's office are deemed to be essential. The Federal Public Defender and his staff will continue to perform duties relating to and in support of Article III functions until further order of the court. Any functions not related to the exercise of judicial power will be suspended.
