ORDER OF APPOINTMENT


UPON THE MOTION OF ROBERT B. LEE, CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER OF THIS COURT, and it appearing to the Court that the services of an additional Probation Officer are required in this district and that JOHN WILLIAM VANDERWULP, JR. is a suitable person to serve as such Probation Officer in the Seattle Office.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said JOHN WILLIAM VANDERWULP, JR. be, and he is hereby appointed Probation Officer of this Court and within the jurisdiction thereof for the purposes set out in the Act of Congress approved June 6, 1930 entitled "An Act to Provide for the Establishment of a Probation System in the United States Courts, excepting in the District of Columbia, (Title 18, U.S. Code, Section 3654)."

This appointment shall take effect December 28, 1992.

Said JOHN WILLIAM VANDERWULP, JR. shall serve at a salary to be fixed by the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts and shall receive reimbursement for expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of his duties.
