2 Notwithstanding the above provisions, the United States
3 Marshal's Service may make service:

4 (i) On behalf of the United States;

5 (ii) on behalf of any party authorized to proceed
6 in forma pauperis pursuant to Title 28, U.S.C.
7 §1915;

8 (iii) pursuant to any statutory provision expressly
9 providing for service by a United States marshal
10 or his deputy;

11 (iv) in situations which require an enforcement presence,
12 such as temporary restraining orders, injunctions,
13 attachments, arrests and orders relating to judicial
14 sales; or

15 (v) upon order of the court.

16 This amendment shall be effective immediately upon
17 the filing of this order.
