Petitions for habeas corpus, if in proper order, shall be
filed upon receipt of the \$5. filing fee.

Any inmate who wishes to proceed in forma pauperis must have
an authorized officer at the penal institution complete the certificate
as to the amount of money and securities on deposit to his credit in
the institution as required by Rule 3a. The Clerk is instructed to
inform the petitioner that if his prison account exceeds the amount
of \$100⁰⁰, he must pay the filing fee as required by the rule.
