In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. §631, et seq., and further authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that Walter T. Greenaway is hereby reappointed part-time United States Magistrate, with official station at Port Angeles, Washington, at the salary fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States for the designated official station.

The said United States Magistrate shall enter upon the performance of his duties at Port Angeles, Washington, on the 15th day of February 1987, or as soon thereafter as he may be sworn in. The said part-time United States Magistrate is to hold and discharge the duties of said office for a term of four (4) years from the 15th day of February, 1987, unless sooner removed, subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §631(c).

The said United States Magistrate is hereby specifically designated to exercise jurisdiction to try persons accused of, and sentence persons convicted of, misdemeanor offenses committed within the Western District of Washington, as those terms are used in 18 U.S.C §3401(a).

The Clerk shall cause certified copies of this Order to be delivered to the said United States Magistrate and to the United States Attorney for this District; shall cause certified copies of this Order to be spread upon the records of the Court at Seattle and at Tacoma; and shall forward a certified copy of this Order to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts as required by 28 U.S.C. §631(g).
