The local Civil Rules ("CRs") of this Court are hereby amended as follows:

(1) Rule CR 41(b) is amended to read as follows:

CR 41

DISMISSAL OF ACTIONS

(b) Involuntary Dismissal: Effect Thereof

(1) All cases that have been pending in this Court for more than one year without any proceeding of record having been taken may be dismissed by the Court on its own motion for lack of prosecution.

(2) A party proceeding pro se shall keep the Court and opposing parties advised as to his current address. If mail directed to a pro se plaintiff by the Clerk is returned by the Post Office, and if such plaintiff fails to notify the Court and opposing parties within 60 days thereafter of his current address, the Court may dismiss the action without prejudice for failure to prosecute.

1 (2) Rule CR 103(a) is amended to read as follows:

3 PRISONER COMPLAINTS UNDER
4 CIVIL RIGHTS ACT, 42 U.S.C. §1983

5 (a) Form of Complaint

6 Complaints filed pursuant to the Civil Rights Act,
7 42 U.S.C. §1983 by or on behalf of prisoners, shall be
8 typewritten or legibly handwritten, and signed by each
9 plaintiff. Such complaints shall be on the forms
10 supplied by the Court unless the district judge or
11 magistrate, upon finding that the complaint is under-
12 standable and that it conforms with the local rules and
13 the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, in his or her
14 discretion, accepts for filing a complaint that is not
15 submitted on the appropriate forms.

16 These amendments shall be effective immediately upon
17 the filing of this Order.


