Rule 512 of the Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, effective October 1, 1973, vests the authority to designate and terminate the designations of bankruptcy depositories in the referees rather than the judges of the district court, and provides that securities deposited in lieu of a surety upon a depository bond shall be subject to the order of the referees. Pursuant to the Advisory Committee's Note that depository bonds should be filed with the bankruptcy court rather than the clerk of the court, the clerk of this Court is hereby authorized and directed to deliver to the bankruptcy court all records of designations of depositories, bonds, and receipts for securities deposited with the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco.
