

JUDGE LIN’S PRE-TRIAL SUBMISSION & EVENT DEADLINES

Parties must also refer to the deadlines set in the Local Criminal Rules for the Western District of Washington (“CrR”), including Appendix A of those rules, and Judge Lin’s Standing Order for All Criminal Cases (“SOACC”). Please note that a number of the deadlines in Judge Lin’s SOACC depart from the deadlines set in the CrR. Unless the Court has ordered otherwise (*e.g.*, at the pretrial conference (“PTC”)) or in a scheduling order, and to the extent these deadlines conflict with those found in the CrR, these deadlines will control.
