The local Criminal Rules ("CrRs") of this Court are hereby amended as follows:

A new rule, designated Rule CrR 32(c) (3) (A), shall be added, and shall provide as follows:

(c) (3) (A) Each copy of a probation department presentence report which this court has or does make available to the United States Parole Commission or the Bureau of Prisons for any reason whatever constitutes a confidential court document and shall be presumed to remain under the continuing control of the court during the time that such presentence report is in the temporary custody of either of those agencies. Such copy of the presentence report shall be loaned to the Parole Commission and the Bureau of Prisons only for the purpose of enabling those agencies to carry out their official functions, including parole release and supervision, and shall be returned to this court after such use, or earlier upon the request of this court.
