The Local Civil Rules ("CRs") of the Western District of
Washington are hereby amended as follows:

CR 4

SERVICE OF PROCESS

(j) Action to Abate if Defendant not Served


The summons and complaint must be served on each
defendant within [~~three-months~~] 120 days after the issuance of the
summons. Unless a defendant has been served within said time, or
has appeared generally in the cause, or service on him has been
begun pursuant to Rule 4(e) of the Federal Rules of Civil
Procedure, the action against him shall abate; provided, however,
that a plaintiff whose time to effect service has not expired may
from time to time, for good cause shown, procure an order ex parte
extending his time to serve the summons and complaint for such
further period (not exceeding three additional months in any one
order) as the court may direct.
