ORDER

Pursuant to the Guide to the Judiciary Policies and Procedures, Chapter V, Travel and Transportation, part D, Use of General Services Administration Vehicles by Employees of the Federal Probation System, the probation officers assigned to this court may in the performance of their official duties use GSA vehicles to transport themselves between their place of employment and residence when, in the judgment of the chief probation officer, such travel is consistent with applicable regulations regarding the use of GSA vehicles by probation officers.

The chief probation officer or his designee will review each request and issue specific authorization where in his judgment the necessary conditions are met.
