Pursuant to the Guide to the Judiciary Policies and Procedures, Chapter V, Travel and Transportation, part D, Use of General Services Administration Vehicles by Employees of the Federal Probation System, probation officers assigned to this court may in the performance of their official duties transport nongovernment personnel in GSA cars where, in the judgment of the officer, the circumstances justify doing so. The probation officer shall be responsible to make a record of each instance as required by the above regulation.
