BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Effective forthwith, and until further order of a majority of the judges of this district in regular active service, it shall be the policy of the judges of this district that any member of this court, who retires from regular active service pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 371(b) and other applicable statutes, shall be privileged to retain the use of his courtroom and chambers so long as he is doing a "substantial amount" of judicial work. (See Report of Judicial Conference of the United States, September 1950, pp. 21-22.)
