Civil Rule 101 for the Western District of Washington is hereby amended to read as follows:

CR 101

CASES REMOVED FROM STATE COURTS


(a) If the complaint filed in state court does not set forth the dollar amount prayed for, a removal petition shall nevertheless be governed by the time limitation of Title 28 U.S.C. § 1446(b) if a reasonable person, reading the complaint of the plaintiff, would conclude that the plaintiff was seeking damages in an amount greater than the minimum jurisdictional amount of this Court. The verified petition for removal shall in that event set forth the reasons which cause petitioner to have a good faith belief that the plaintiff is seeking damages in excess of the jurisdictional amount of this Court notwithstanding the fact that the prayer of the complaint does not specify the dollar damages being sought.

ORDER - 1

1 (b) Each petitioner for removal under Chapter 89
2 of Title 28, United States Code, shall, within ten
3 days of filing his petition for removal, file with
4 the Clerk of this Court black-on-white copies of all
5 records and proceedings in the State Court, together
6 with his or his counsel's verification that they are
7 true and complete copies of all the records and
8 proceedings in the State Court proceeding. The
9 copies need not be certified or exemplified by the
10 State Court, and the added cost of certification or
11 exemplification will not be allowed as a cost item
12 under 28 U.S.C. Section 1920(4) unless certification
13 is required after an opposing party challenges the
14 accuracy of the copies. Records and proceedings in
15 the State Court, filed with the petition, need not be
16 refiled.

17 This amendment shall be effective May 21, 1981.
