PART I: REFERRAL OF BANKRUPTCY CASES AND PROCEEDINGS

1.01 CASES AND PROCEEDINGS UNDER TITLE 11, UNITED STATES CODE

This court hereby refers to the bankruptcy judges of this district all cases under title 11, and all proceedings arising under title 11 or arising in or related to cases under title 11.

1.02 CASES AND PROCEEDINGS UNDER THE BANKRUPTCY ACT OF 1898

The bankruptcy judges of this district shall hear and determine cases and proceedings arising under the Bankruptcy Act of 1898, as amended, pursuant to sec. 403(a) of the Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1978.

PART II: BANKRUPTCY APPEALS

2.01 BANKRUPTCY APPELLATE PANEL

(a) Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 158(b)(2), this court hereby authorizes a bankruptcy appellate panel to hear and determine appeals from judgments, orders, and decrees entered by bankruptcy judges from this district, subject to the limitations set forth in

1 subparagraphs (b)-(d).

2 (b) The bankruptcy appellate panel may hear and determine  
3 only those appeals in which all parties to the appeal consent  
4 thereto pursuant to paragraph 2.02 of this order.

5 (c) The bankruptcy appellate panel may hear and determine  
6 appeals from final judgments, orders, and decrees entered by  
7 bankruptcy judges and, with leave of the bankruptcy appellate  
8 panel, appeals from interlocutory orders and decrees entered by  
9 bankruptcy judges.

10 (d) The bankruptcy appellate panel may hear and determine  
11 appeals from judgments, orders, and decrees entered by bankruptcy  
12 judges after July 20, 1984, and appeals transferred to this court  
13 from the previous Ninth Circuit bankruptcy appellate panel by sec.  
14 115(b) of The Bankruptcy Amendments and Federal Judgeship Act of  
15 1984, P.L. 98-353. The bankruptcy appellate panel may not hear  
16 and determine appeals from judgments, orders, and decrees entered  
17 by bankruptcy judges between December 25, 1982, and July 10, 1984,  
18 under the Emergency Bankruptcy Rule of this district.

19 2.03 FORM AND TIME OF CONSENT

20 (a) The consent of a party to allow an appeal to be heard  
21 and determined by the bankruptcy appellate panel shall be deemed  
22 to have been given unless written objection thereto is timely made  
23 in accordance with Paragraph 2 of the Amended Order Establishing  
24 and Continuing the Bankruptcy Appellate Panel of the Ninth  
25 Circuit, a copy of which is attached to this order and  
26 incorporated herein by reference.

1 2.03 RULES GOVERNING BANKRUPTCY APPEALS

2 (a) Practice in such bankruptcy appeals as may come before  
3 this district shall be governed by Part VIII of the Rules of  
4 Bankruptcy Procedure, except as provided in this order or in rules  
5 subsequently adopted by this district court.

6 (b) Notwithstanding subparagraph (a), the time for filing  
7 appellant's, appellee's, and reply briefs for consideration by the  
8 district court shall be 40 days, 30 days, and 14 days,  
9 respectively, in lieu of the time limits specified in Rule 8009(a)  
10 of the Rules of Bankruptcy procedure, provided, however, that the  
11 district court or the bankruptcy appellate panel may shorten these  
12 time limits in appropriate cases.

13 PART III: EFFECTIVE DATE

14 This order shall become effective immediately and supersede  
15 all previous orders of this court regarding bankruptcy cases,
