It is hereby ORDERED:

- (a) The United States Magistrates in this district are authorized to grant, upon an appropriate showing, orders authorizing entry on premises by officers of the United States to effect levies in enforcement of the internal revenue laws.
- (b) Applications for such orders shall be in writing and under oath. They are to be filed initially with the Clerk of this Court, and referred directly to a United States Magistrate.
- (c) The officer executing such an order shall, within ten days after the execution of the order, or within such time as the order provides, file a return with the Clerk of this Court. Said return shall be in writing and under oath. It shall inventory all property, books, papers and other
