In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C.,
§631, et seq., and further authority granted and action
taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States,
it is

ORDERED that Stanley R. King is hereby reappointed
part-time United States Magistrate, with official station
at Longmire, Washington, at the salary fixed by the Judicial
Conference of the United States for the designated official
station.

The said United States Magistrate shall enter upon
the performance of his duties at Longmire, Washington,
on the 2nd day of July, 1982, or as soon thereafter as
he may be sworn in. If possible, he shall take the oath
or affirmations prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§453 and 631(f)
and 5 U.S.C. §3331, before the 1st day of July, 1982.

The said part-time United States Magistrate is to
hold and discharge the duties of said office for a term
of four (4) years from the 2nd day of July, 1982, unless
sooner removed, subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C.
§631(c).
