General Order.

Pursuant to the provisions of [23 of the Judicial Code (Title 28, U.S.C.A., | 27) the undersigned Judges of this District have agreed upon a division of the business and assignment of causes for trial in this District as follows:

Unless otherwise directed, commencing with the date of filing of this Order, Judge Edward E. Cushman will dispose of all causes and proceedings in the Southern Division of the District, and Judge Jeremiah Neterer will dispose of all of the causes and proceedings tried or heard in the City of Bellingham in the Northern Division.

Of the causes and proceedings tried or heard at Seattle, hereafter filed, Judge Edward E. Cushman will dispose of one-fourth of the Criminal cases, one-fourth of the Civil jury cases and one-fourth of the Equity causes -- that is, each of such cases the Clerk's file number of which is divisible by four; Judge Meremiah Neterer will dispose of all marine admiralty causes; The remaining cases, causes and proceedings tried or heard at Seattle, in the Northern Division will be disposed of by Judge John C. Bowen.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all Orders and agreements concerning the division of business and assignment of causes heretofore had or made are by this Order vacated.

The Clerk is directed, in making up all calendars of cases, causes and proceedings at Seattle, unless otherwise directed, to observe the provisions of this Order.
