



by the U. S. Probation Officer assigned to his or her case.  
Such defendant need not secure approval by the court, notwithstanding the terms of the appearance bond. A failure to comply with the directions of the Probation Officer, however, shall be deemed a violation of the bond.

The pretrial diversion coordinator in the office of the United States Attorney is authorized to so advise each defendant at the time he or she is accepted into the diversion program.
