- 2. Where the United States elects to proceed in the foregoing manner, a uncertified copy of this general order should be filed with the complaint when it is filed with the Clerk of the Court.
- 3. After a summons is issued, it together with the complaint shall be served in the manner provided by Rule 4, Rules of Civil Procedures. Thereafter, the person serving process shall file an
