Based upon the motion of the United States, it is hereby:
Ordered:

1. That in cases brought by the United States of America to collect educational loans made by or guaranteed by the United States of America, the United States is authorized to arrange for service of the summons and complaint by persons of suitable age and description over eighteen years of age.

2. Where the United States elects to proceed in the foregoing manner, a uncertified copy of this general order should be filed with the complaint when it is filed with the Clerk of the Court.


3. After a summons is issued, it together with the complaint shall be served in the manner provided by Rule 4, Rules of Civil Procedures. Thereafter, the person serving process shall file an

1 affidavit with the Court specifying the name and business address
2 of the person serving process. The affidavit should also specify
3 date, place and the manner in which the summons and complaint were
4 served. The individuals listed on the attached page are
5 authorized to serve process in these cases.
