ORDER OF APPOINTMENT


UPON THE MOTION OF ROBERT B. LEE, CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER  
OF THIS COURT, and it appearing to the Court that the services  
of an additional Probation Officer are required in this District  
and that THOMAS MARTIN HOLTER is a suitable person to serve  
as such Probation Officer in the Tacoma office,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said THOMAS MARTIN HOLTER be,  
and he is hereby appointed Probation Officer of this Court and  
within the jurisdiction thereof for the purposes set out in  
the Act of Congress approved June 6, 1930 entitled "An Act to  
Provide for the Establishment of a Probation System in the United
