ORDER REGARDING THE FILING OF
MASON COUNTY BANKRUPTCY CASES

It appearing that Bankruptcy Court hearings for Kitsap County, and counties north of Grays Harbor County on the Olympic Peninsula heretofore held at Seattle, may be heard in the City of Bremerton and it further appearing that Civil Rule 5(e) of the Local Rules of this Court requires that civil cases from certain counties, including Mason County, be filed at Tacoma, and that further, for the convenience of creditors, parties and counsel, cases originating in Mason County should be heard in Bremerton, and that this will require filing of Mason County cases in Seattle.

Now, therefore, it is ordered that bankruptcy cases originating in Mason County shall be filed at Seattle.
