The current eight-year term of office of full-time United States Magistrate Judge Brian A. Tsuchida at Seattle, Washington is due to expire May 12, 2024. The United States District Court is required by law to establish a merit selection panel to review Magistrate Judge Tsuchida's performance and consider his reappointment to a new eight-year term.

The duties of the magistrate judge position include the following:

- (1) The trial and disposition of civil cases upon consent of litigants;
- (2) Conduct preliminary proceedings in felony cases;
- (3) Trial and disposition at the Federal Courthouses in the Western District of Washington of petty and misdemeanor cases arising from outlying government facilities;
- (4) Trial and disposition of other federal misdemeanor cases;
- (5) Assisting district judges in disposition of prisoner petitions and Social Security appeals;
- (6) Conducting various pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings on reference from the judges of the District Court;
- (7) Conducting settlement conferences.
