Judge Kymerly K. Evanson, United States District Judge for the Western District of Washington, seeks a full-time judicial extern to work in-person during winter/spring 2027. Judge Evanson only accepts 3Ls as externs. Externs may seek school credit, but they need not do so. School-year externships are unpaid.

Judicial externs support the work of chambers through legal research and writing, including bench memoranda, draft rulings and orders, and other advocacy assignments. Judge Evanson encourages her externs to attend court hearings and trials as available.

Applicants must submit the following documents, combined into one PDF, via email to elizabeth_tutmarc@wawd.uscourts.gov:

- Cover letter, describing your interest in a judicial externship with Judge Evanson and any relevant educational, professional, or life experiences that will inform your work as a judicial extern
- Résumé
- Writing sample (no longer than 10 pages)

If selected for an interview, candidates must provide the following:

- An unofficial law school transcript
- A list of three professional and/or academic references

The successful candidate must undergo a background investigation with law enforcement agencies, including fingerprint and criminal record checks, and must be legally eligible to be employed by the Judiciary to be considered (even though the position is unpaid).

Judge Evanson's chambers will accept applications through August 31, 2026, although the position may be filled before that date. Interviews will be conducted on a rolling basis; interested applicants are encouraged to apply as soon as possible.
