GENERAL ORDER NO. 15-21

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(f), in an emergency and upon the concurrence of the chief judges of the districts involved, a United States magistrate judge may be temporarily assigned to perform any of the duties specified in subsections (a), (b), or (c) of this section in a judicial district other than the judicial district for which he or she has been appointed.

Due to the emergency resulting from the ascension of the Yakima-based magistrate judge in the Eastern District of Washington to an Article III judge position in Spokane, and the inescapable delay in completion of the background investigation for her successor, the district certifies the need for magistrate judge assistance from the Western District of Washington.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED, with the concurrence of the Honorable Stanley A.

Bastian, Chief United States District Judge of the Eastern District of Washington,

that ALL United States Magistrate Judges from the Western District of Washington are hereby designated to hold court and perform any and all judicial duties designated under 28 U.S.C. § 636, subsections (a), (b), and (c), in the Eastern District of Washington, from the period of January 3, 2022, through January 31, 2022.
