GENERAL ORDER NO. 12-25

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(f), in an emergency and upon the concurrence of the chief judges of the districts involved, a United States magistrate judge may be temporarily assigned to perform any of the duties specified in subsections (a), (b), or (c) of this section in a judicial district other than the judicial district for which he or she has been appointed.

Due to an emergency resulting from the recusal of all currently serving magistrate judges, the Western District of Washington has certified the need for magistrate judge assistance from the Eastern District of Washington.

Therefore, **IT IS ORDERED**, with the concurrence of the Honorable Stanley A. Bastian, Chief United States District Judge of the Eastern District of Washington, United States Magistrate Judge Alexander C. Ekstrom is hereby designated to hold court and perform any and all judicial duties designated under 28 U.S.C. § 636, subsections (a), (b), and (c), in the Western District of
